

The Hub

The hub is a central database which provides information on all the titles the NLA covers including title name, publisher and licence types.

All titles can be searched for using our [title search](#)

Alternatively, API calls can be used to generate a list of titles all at once. Details of how to do this and the different queries you can run are laid out in this document.

Please note, magazines are licensed by the NLA in the **UK ONLY**.

Before You Start

Ensure that you replace the red highlighted generic username and password in each of the links below (if you don't know your details this can be requested from support@nla.co.uk), as follows:

Note: All results will be exported in CSV format

Q: How do I create a list of the entire NLA repertoire?

A: Paste the following link into your internet browser:

Q: How do I filter the repertoire list by newspapers, web or print?

A: Newspapers: **dlo=NLA** as shown in the red highlighted text in the link below

Q: How do I filter the repertoire list by media type?

A: Leave the red highlighted text in the link blank to get print AND web titles

A: To get print titles only, use the following link:

Q: How can I check for changes within a specific date range?

A: Using the link below. The period can be a number, in which case the call returns titles that have had changes in the last X number of days, or it can be a date range, using the format as follows:

Change Reason	Description
Licence Changed	The title has been included in an optional licence OR excluded from an optional licence. Optional licences include: "WDL" (Web Database Licence) "PCA Database" (eClips)
Name Changed	The title name has changed (name or URL)
Status Changed	The title is "Active" or "Closed" (ceased publication).
New	The title has recently been added to the NLA licensed repertoire.

Q: How do I see a list of all the new titles added to the NLA repertoire in the past 3 months?

A: This call will return all entries in the database which match against the filter values AND which have been added to the NLA repertoire in the previous 3 month period.
