

# eClips Ireland PCA Licence and End User Licence Agreement - Frequently Asked Questions

### ***1. Which NLA newspapers are covered under the eClips Ireland End User Licence Agreement***

### ***2. How can I get UK newspaper (eClips Ireland) content from my eClips Ireland licensed PCA?***

You can receive eClips Ireland content (Financial Times, Belfast Telegraph, NewsLetter and the Eire and Ulster version of the UK national newspapers) if your PCA has an eClips Ireland PCA Licence, or a UK PCA Licence and you register for an eClips Ireland End User Licence or have a UK digital licence.

### ***3. How can I register for an eClips Ireland End User Licence?***

### ***4. What is the NLA going to charge me for receiving content from an eClips Ireland licensed PCA?***

NLA has a direct financial relationship with your PCA and will charge them directly for sending you links to eClips Ireland content. As a result of this NLA will not invoice you directly for receiving links of eClips Ireland content.

### ***5. Can I print a copy of what I receive?***

If you have signed the eClips Ireland End User Licence you may print off **a single copy** of what you receive per registered user. If you wish to print off multiple copies of eClips Ireland content or NLA content outside of the eClips Ireland content set you must either report them to NLI (If based in Eire), or direct to NLA (If based in Ulster).

### ***6. Can I make further digital copies of what I receive?***

Not under the terms of the End User Licence Agreement but you can if you hold standard NLA digital licence and report this copying to NLA.

**7. *What happens if I need content outside the eClips Ireland content set?***

If your PCA holds a standard NLA PCA agreement, then they can provide you with additional content, provided you hold a standard UK NLA end user licence as well as the eClips Ireland End User Licence. If your PCA only holds an eClips Ireland PCA Licence they can only send you content from the eClips Ireland content list (10 titles).

**8. *I have an existing standard NLA licence so why do I need to fill out an eClips Ireland End User Agreement?***

The terms you have agreed to under your standard NLA Licence are very different from the eClips Ireland End User Agreement and your (eClips Ireland Licensed) PCA has no rights to send you NLA content, or to pay NLA fees on your behalf, unless you have registered for eClips Ireland through the End User Licence Agreement.

## **Irish PCAs**

**1. *I want to supply NLA (UK newspaper) content to an Irish end user. What are the rules?***

You may supply eClips Ireland content (10 titles only) provided you hold an eClips Ireland PCA Licence and the end user has an eClips Ireland End User Licence.

**2. *What if I want to supply content outside of the eClips Ireland content set to an Irish end user?***

You may supply content outside the eClips Ireland content set, provided you hold a standard NLA PCA Licence as well as the eClips Ireland Licence. If you wish to supply content outside of the eClips Ireland content set, the end user must also have a standard UK NLA end user licence.

**3. *Can I supply an end user with PDFs?***

No. You may only provide links (to eClips or your own website, as applicable).

**4. *What is eClips Ireland PCA Licence going to cost me?***

NLA costs for eClips Ireland licensed PCAs are based on a fee per link delivered to end users at your clients. The fee per link delivered is €0.30 for up to and including 3 users and then €0.10 per link for each additional user.

**5. *What if I want to receive content outside of the eClips Ireland content set from a UK PCA?***

You can also receive other NLA content if you hold a standard UK PCA Licence and/or a standard eClips PCA Licence (if the content received is from NLA's eClips database and outside the eClips Ireland repertoire).

**6. *Can I receive PDFs of UK content from a UK PCA?***

No, from 1 April 2009 you may only receive links (from eClips or from the UK PCAs own website as applicable)
